Task 02

Announcer: Listen to the second part of the interview between Lukas and Ms Bailey, his job coach.

Lukas: That seems like a good idea. So now the interview steps?

Ms Bailey: Yes. Use the 5 magic words at least once during your interview; 1 from each of the C.M.A.D.E. pairs. Tap with your fingers on your knee, as you use one from each letter pair.
